

ColigoCare Website Privacy Policy

Effective Date: September 21, 2026

This Privacy Policy (“**Policy**”) describes how ColigoCare (“**ColigoCare**,” “**we**,” “**our**,” “**us**”) collects personal information from you or about you through our website at www.coligocare.com (the “**Site**”). This Policy explains why we collect this information, how we may use or disclose this information, and the choices you have with regard to the information we maintain.

Information Collection

Personal Information You Provide. You may submit personal information, which is information that can be used to identify you individually, when you interact with the Site. For example, we may collect contact information, such as your name, email address, postal address, or phone number, when you contact ColigoCare, request information, complete a form, enroll in available services, or otherwise communicate with us.

Depending on how you interact with ColigoCare, we may also collect information you choose to provide in connection with ColigoCare services, programs, events, network participation activities, or communications, including information needed to respond to your request or support your participation.

Information Collected Automatically. We, and the vendors we work with, may use tracking technologies, such as cookies, log files, pixels, analytics tools, embedded media technologies, and similar technologies, that automatically or passively collect certain information from visitors on the Site. This information may include IP addresses, device identifiers, language preferences, referring URLs, browser and platform details, and information about how visitors interact with the Site.

Cookies are small data files stored on a computer's hard drive that allow a website to recognize a visitor's device, record visitor preferences, track the pages a user visits on a website, and identify the referral website. Cookies help us understand how you use the Site and enhance your visitor experience. Where required or implemented by ColigoCare, users may manage preferences regarding non-essential cookies and tracking technologies through the Site's cookie preference center. Users may accept, reject, or modify preferences for certain categories of cookies at any time. Most browsers automatically accept these cookies, but you usually can change your browser setting to remove or reject cookies. Please note that blocking cookies on our Site may prevent you

from using some of the features of our Site. Also, disabling cookies may invalidate opt-outs that use cookies to recognize devices that have opted out.

We and our service providers may use analytics providers, website hosting providers, embedded media providers, interactive tools, form-processing tools, and similar technologies to operate, maintain, and improve the Site; understand details about your use of certain pages, including website usage and performance; process communications or requests you submit through the Site; and personalize certain features and functionality, such as personalizing content for you.

Use of Information Collected

We and our vendors may use the personal information collected through the Site for various purposes, including:

- to communicate with you and send you information that may be of interest to you, including information about ColigoCare services, programs, events, and related updates;
- to personalize your user experience;
- to monitor and analyze trends, usage, and activities of visitors;
- to take certain action with regard to any suspected or actual fraudulent or illegal activity or activity that violates our policies;
- to comply with applicable laws, rules, regulations, and legal processes; and
- for any other purpose, with your consent.

Disclosure of Personal Information

We may disclose personal information we have collected through the Site to our business partners and vendors. For example, we may use service providers to help us operate the Site, communicate with you, or administer activities on our behalf. In addition, we may disclose personal information in the event we sell or transfer all or a portion of our business assets or with your consent or at your direction.

Messaging Consent Data. We do not sell, rent, or share your mobile phone number, text messaging opt-in data, or consent information with third parties or affiliates for their marketing or promotional purposes. All categories of information described in this Policy exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with third parties for marketing or promotional purposes. We may share mobile information and

messaging data with service providers only as needed to deliver, administer, support, or improve text messaging services on ColigoCare's behalf, or as otherwise permitted or required by law.

ColigoCare also may disclose your personal information (1) to comply with legal requirements; (2) to protect or defend ColigoCare; (3) where we perceive a threat or risk to individuals or property as a result of activity on our Site; (4) in connection with an individual's inappropriate use of our Site; or (5) with your consent or at your direction.

Security

We take reasonable precautions to help protect your information from unauthorized access and disclosure; however, no transmission over the Internet is completely secure. Accordingly, we cannot guarantee the security of information collected through our Site.

Links

Our Site may contain links to features or websites that are not operated by us, including social networks operated by unaffiliated parties. Please be aware that this Policy does not apply to information collected through those websites. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of those websites, and we encourage you to review their privacy statements.

Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect personal information from individuals under the age of 13. If we become aware that we have obtained information from users under the age of 13, we will delete such information in accordance with applicable law.

Information for Users Outside the United States

Please be aware that any personal information you submit will be transferred to and processed in the United States and the data protection laws and regulations that apply to your personal information may be different from the laws in your country of residence.
